Winemaker's Notes

Kalecik Karasi, a dark-skinned Turkish grape primarily employed for crafting red wines, yields light to medium-bodied expressions. Named after the flourishing Kalecik region in Ankara Province. In the production of this wine, the grapes are meticulously hand-harvested and undergo fermentation in stainless steel tanks to maintain the fruit characteristics of this varietal

Tasting Notes

This rosé wine has scents of cherry, raspberry, and fresh fig on the nose, this wine maintains an aromatic and enduring presence on the palate. It complements appetizers, seafood, and pizza seamlessly.

About the Region

The **Çal** plateau, ranging from 850 to 1200 meters in altitude, features clay-limestone and mineral-rich soils conducive to producing grapes with distinctive mineral richness, high acidity, and freshness. With its ideal climate and environmental conditions for viticulture, Çal contributes significantly to Turkey's viticultural landscape, representing 20% of the nation's vineyard areas and wine grape production.



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
