

# 2022 Emir HUS Winery - Turkey

Established in 2018 by Juan Pablo Diaz Leon and Ceylan Ertörer Diaz Leon, HUS Winery is a family-owned venture situated in Urla, on the outskirts of Izmir. The core philosophy of HUS revolves around crafting wines that authentically embody their roots. The winery's story traces back to the migration of Ceylan's grandmother from Crete to Urla during the population exchange in 1923.

## Winemaker's Notes

Aged for 6 months in stainless steel tanks, Emir constitutes 25% of Cappadocia's overall grape production. This Turkish grape flourishes in the region's harsh winters and elevated terrain, reaching approximately 1,200 meters. Thriving on the volcanic, mineral-rich soils, Emir yields grapes used for both still and sparkling wines. Characterized by oval, green-yellow, medium-sized fruit, Emir wines are delicate, light to medium-bodied, pale yellow in hue, and notable for their robust acidity.

## Tasting Notes

Aromas of lime and citrus, coupled with a medium to high acidity, culminate in a refreshing and mineral finish. Ideal for pairing with fish and seafood.

## About the Region

**Cappadocia** is a significant region in Turkey's viticulture and grape cultivation. Due to the characteristics of its terrain, the region is incredibly conducive to the production of high-quality grapes. Sand, sandstone, and decomposed volcanic tuff make up the region's soil and help to produce grapes of high quality that are used to make wine. Nearly 20% of all Turkish wine is made in the Cappadocia region.
